The MGNS Board of Directors sets school policy, considers new programs, approves tuition rates, etc. In addition to the board's overall leadership role, individual board members also have specific jobs they do on behalf of the school (e.g. volunteer coordinator, advertising coordinator, etc.). Meetings are held monthly at MGNS and last an average of 1-2 hours.
