#### A BRIEFING FROM THE BOARD

When we celebrated our 60th year as a school last year, we decided the occasion was a good opportunity to look forward and define the future. Our board did some strategic planning over last winter and spring, and that process is still powering a lot of the work the board is doing this year. In the strategic planning process, the board honed in on the opportunities: (1) to invest in our facility and improve its safety with new security features, (2) to expand our programming, and (3) to engage in long-term fiscal planning to put ourselves on the best possible financial footing.

Our board is an active and engaged group of parents working to make MGNS the best it can be. I thank them heartily for all they do, and I invite all of you to start thinking now about being part of this wonderful group in 2020-21 if this year is not your last! You have seen -- and will see -- the results of some of this work later this year. If you've walked our halls before this school year started, you might have noticed quite a bit of fresh paint, new bulletin boards, and a new wall of donor blocks. Later this fall, you will notice security updates, including new locks on the front doors so that the doors will automatically unlock just before pick-up time and re-lock afterwards, among other things.

On the programming front, we are now planning new, optional, special programming for kids on Mondays in the 4K room with potential themes like water play, cooking, and science. Look for more details about this winter.

#### PLAY DOUGH RECIPE

#### **HOW TO MAKE PLAYDOUGH**

Playdough ingredients:

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 3/4 cup salt
- 4 teaspoons cream of tartar
- 2 cups lukewarm water
- 2 Tablespoons of vegetable oil (coconut oil works too)
- Food coloring, optional
- Quart sized bags

Stir together the flour, salt and cream of tartar in a large pot. Next add the water and oil. If you're only making one color, add in the the color now as well. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly. Continue stirring until the dough has thickened and begins to form into a ball. Remove from heat and then place inside a gallon sized bag or onto wax paper. Allow to cool slightly and then knead until smooth. If you're adding colors after, divide the dough into balls (for how many colors you want) and then add the dough into the quart sized bags. Start with about 5 drops of color and add more to brighten it. Knead the dough, while inside the bag so it doesn't stain your hands. Once it's all mixed together you're ready to PLAY.
