We want you to have your next shipment in time for December holidays! Orders should be placed no later than Thursday, November 4 to accommodate the longer shipping times. We will be submitting orders as they come in. To place an order, simply go online and use our school code. Place your order, pay, and when books arrive at school, they will be placed in your child's bin or brown bag. You can choose to have books shipped directly to your home; however, Scholastic has informed us that that option may actually take longer. \*Please list your child's first and last name along with their class name on your order. \*\*If you'd like your order to be a surprise, let us know and you can pick up your order in the office!
